Fill out your charity's info


- Complete the form. Make sure to choose "Yes" to confirm that your organization is a registered charity.

- PayPal requires all account holders to prove their identity with this information.
- We ask for your SSN but will not run a credit check.



Link your bank account


- Please follow the prompt on the previous screen or the notification on your account home page to link your charity's bank account.

Enroll in PayPal Giving Fund

- Upon account confirmation, many charities will see that they're also enrolled in PayPal Giving Fund (PPGF), but some may need to fill out a short form to enroll, including any charities based in California.
- Get started by clicking Enroll


Raising funds to benefit charities

PayPal Giving Fund helps people support their favorite charities online. We receive donations through PayPal, eBay, and other technology platforms and make grants to our donors' recommended charities. PayPal Giving Fund is an IRS-registered 501(c)(3) public charity (Federal Tax ID: 45-0931286).



Enrollment Pending

Welcome to PayPal Giving Fund

We determined that you are eligible to benefit from PayPal Giving Fund programs. Under the PayPal User Agreement, we enroll eligible charities with PayPal Giving Fund without you having to take any further action. If you don't want to benefit from PayPal Giving Fund programs, or do not wish to receive optional email communications from PayPal Giving Fund, you can opt-out at any time by contacting us.

Now that you've completed enrollment, we recommend that you:

Explore your Dashboard and update your profile

Go to your PayPal Giving Fund Dashboard to see a full breakdown of all the donations included in grants you'll receive from us, along with donors' information (when shared). You can even preview donations that'll be included in future grants by clicking "Pending Donations." Click on Profile to upload your logo and your mission statement and review your cause areas. This will make it easier for donors to find your organization and understand what you do.

Notify your accounting department

It's helpful to tell your accounting department they'll receive grants from PayPal Giving Fund through your charity's PayPal account. Grants are sent as a single payment on or before the 25th of each month, which includes donations received from the 16th of the previous month through the 15th of the month the grant is sent. There's no need to send us receipts for these grants.

Encourage your supporters


Let donors know they can now support your charity on our partners' platforms, including PayPal, eBay, GoFundMe, Humble Bundle, Airbnb, Nextdoor, ShoppingGives, and Zakatify. PayPal Giving Fund doesn't charge charities or donors any fees for our services. Some of our partners may charge fees on donations made through their platforms, which they will disclose at the point of donation.
